
Work Days at Oak Grove Cemetery hosted by the La Crosse Area Genealogical Society, 2025

Meet at Oak Grove Cemetery at 1407 La Crosse Street AND come through the Losey Arch on La Crosse Street from West Avenue. Signs will lead you from the entrance to our work site in the cemetery.

Come when you can and leave when you must - you do not need to stay the whole time. There will be a table with supplies and a person to help direct you.

Choices of activities in our workday include taking digital photographs, verifying information from the stones, or cleaning stones.
